



Venous Insufficiency Examination

Our vascular specialists will perform an ultrasound to confirm the presence of venous disease or venous insufficiency. The ultrasound is a non-invasive exam that uses sound waves to image the veins and the valves inside of veins. The specialist will go over the results and develop a tailored treatment plan.

Duration

Approximately 60-75 minutes for the ultrasound and, if necessary, a compression stocking fitting.

Preparation

- Must be well hydrated, drink plenty of fluids the day prior and the day of the ultrasound
- No caffeine the day of the ultrasound
- If you currently use compression stockings, please DO NOT wear them the day of the ultrasound
